## Secondary School Athletic Training Fellowship

The Jacksonville Sports Medicine Program (JSMP), a non-for-profit agency, founded by Wolfson Children's Hospital, Nemours Children's Clinic, the Duval County Medical Society and the Duval County Public schools is a community health care coalition serving the northeast Florida region since 1984.

### Introducing

The program partners with area health care agencies, providers, sports organizations and schools to promote student athlete safety and sports medicine programming.

The Jack Del Rio Foundation has partnered with the JSMP to recognize the need for licensed athletic trainer services within our area's secondary schools and also the need for emergency equipment availability within our athletic venues.

### Fellowship opportunity:

The JSMP is currently seeking Fellow Athletic Trainers to provide athletic training services.

### Program:

Renewable one year position based upon successful academic progress in graduate level program and outstanding work ethic in providing athletic training services as assigned.

### Application process:

Submit resume, three letters of reference highlighting academic success and leadership qualities of the candidate. Also submit a short summary of your professional goals and how this fellowship opportunity might help you in your professional development. Applications will continue until candidate is placed.

### Requirements:

Graduate of CAATE athletic training program, NATA Certified, Licensure, or eligible, in the state of Florida. Candidates who are independently motivated and possess a strong desire to pursue an athletic training position in the secondary school environment are encouraged to apply.

### Duties:

Selected candidates will provide daily athletic training coverage to an assigned secondary school within the Duval County Public Schools. The duties will include working with a mentor athletic trainer and developing a comprehensive athletic training program. Clinical rotations will be arranged for the selected candidate to enhance the fellowship experience. The candidate will also be responsible for other community and administrative projects from time to time as assigned by the JSMP Director.
